Dear Mr. Street:

Your hospital has been determined eligible to receive the enclosed payment under the Medicaid specialty care hospital disproportionate share (DSH) program. This determination is made based on the formula found in section 409.9118, Florida Statutes, as enacted by the 1997 Legislature, and in compliance with the requirements of federal law, including your certification that you are a provider of obstetrical services or that you meet the exceptions provided by federal law.

Payments are proportional to a hospital's relative effort compared to all other eligible hospitals for providing indigent and Medicaid care. Payments are made from a fixed sum of money. Thus, any adjustments to the amount received by one hospital affects the amounts received by all other hospitals.

Your scheduled first quarter payment (enclosed, if not electronically transferred) represents 50% of your projected annual amount for the 2017-18 fiscal year, based upon an annual appropriation of \$1,433,885.


