Your facility has been determined eligible to receive a GME payment \$57.7 Million distribution in accordance with F.S. 409.909(5) and the general appropriations act for state fiscal year 2016-2017

This one-time payment (electronically transferred) represents approximately 100% of your projected annual amount of \$252,168 for this fiscal year.
