Welcoming Remarks

Roll Call

Subpopulation Committee Topics:

- 1. <u>Behavioral Health Coverage Policies:</u>
 - Rule Development process was reiterated, including: workshop and public input process, use of standardized language for Medicaid Handbooks, the removal of repetitive language in Medicaid Handbooks, and a standardized appearance.
 - Questions were addressed regarding an update to the State Inpatient Psychiatric Program (SIPP) Handbook.



- 2. <u>Update Housing Services Waiver Pilot:</u>
 - Review of the recent presentations in Largo and Orlando by Medicaid Policy staff regarding the amendment request for Florida's 1115 Managed Medical waiver.
 - Confirmation sought regarding the pilot locations: Region 5 and Region 7.
 - Questions were asked regarding the timeframe of submission to CMS.
 - Questions were asked about the potential for opportunity to expand the pilot locations/regions without resubmitting to CMS.
- 3. SB12 (Revenue Maximization)
 - Discussion of draft plan between AHCA and DCF to explore options for revenue maximization.
 - Questions were asked regarding the target population and delivery of services.
 - Clarification was provided regarding the goals of the draft plan to address gaps and overlaps in services, specifically behavioral health services.
- 4. Specialty Provider Types for Residential and Freestanding Psychiatric Providers
 - Discussion regarding proposed specialty provider types for facilities.
 - Clarification was provided that the specialty provider type announcements were planned and it would not require new enrollment, but updated information.
 - Assistance in provider outreach was offered.
- 5. <u>Collaboration: Role of Managing Entities (ME) Related to Authorization/Coordination of</u> <u>Care for Behavioral Health Services for Children</u>:
 - Discussion of possible ongoing collaboration with the Children, Including Safeguards and Performance Measures Related to Foster Children, Subpopulation Committee.
 - Consensus reached that it would be beneficial to collaborate with the Children Subpopulation Committee
 - Plans for a future conference call (or in-person meeting) were discussed and it was suggested that MEs be invited to participate.
