### **October Monthly Actions: Agency Took Licensure Action against Ten Providers**

**Tallahassee, Fla.** – The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) issued final orders to ten providers for failure to meet licensure requirements in October.

There were seven final orders to revoke an existing license, two final orders to deny a license renewal and one that resulted in the provider surrendering their license. Some of these providers were enrolled in the Medicaid program and the Agency has terminated or is in the process of terminating their participation in the program.
