The website offers a suite of interactive tools to locate and compare hospitals, surgery centers, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, health insurance plans, and other health care services.

The website also contains convenient links to the Agency’s licensure and regulatory compliance information for providers, printable consumer guides and additional resources. FloridaHealthFinder.gov received more than 3.7 million visits during 2015.
