As you may know, the Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) was directed by the 2005 Florida Legislature, through Section 409.91211, Florida Statutes, to implement the Medicaid Managed Care Pilot Program. This statute directs the Agency to implement the program in two geographic areas, which included Baker, Broward, Clay, Duval, and Nassau Counties.

Pursuant to this statute, the Agency requested and was granted an 1115 Demonstration Waiver to implement the program. The initial approval period for the waiver was for 5 years (July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2011). Under an 1115 waiver, states are provided with the option to request a 3 year extension after the initial 5 year period.

On April 30, 2010 the Florida Legislature passed Senate Bill 1484. Within this bill, the Florida Legislature directed the Agency to seek approval of a 3 year waiver extension in order to continue operation of the 1115 waiver in Baker, Broward, Clay, Duval and Nassau Counties. The Agency was directed to submit the extension request by no later than July 1, 2010.

Although the Governor has not yet signed this bill into law (and has until May 28th to take final action), the Agency has moved forward as quickly as possible to schedule public meetings regarding the required extension application.

Although the timeline for filing of an extension is short, we are committed to providing the public with as much opportunity for comment as possible. There are currently Public Forums regarding the extension scheduled in Baker, Broward, Clay, Duval and Nassau counties to ensure that citizens, providers and Medicaid recipients in each of the Pilot counties have the opportunity to provide input.
