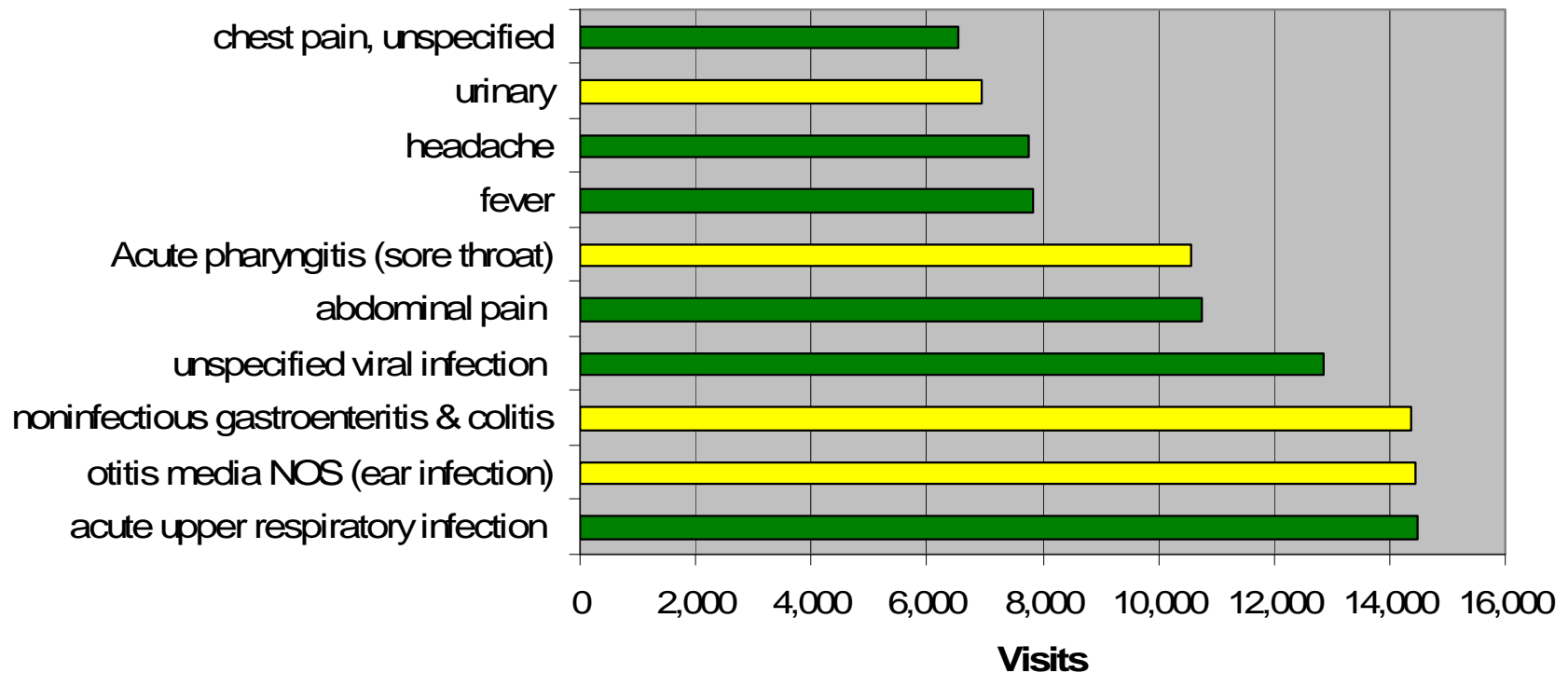

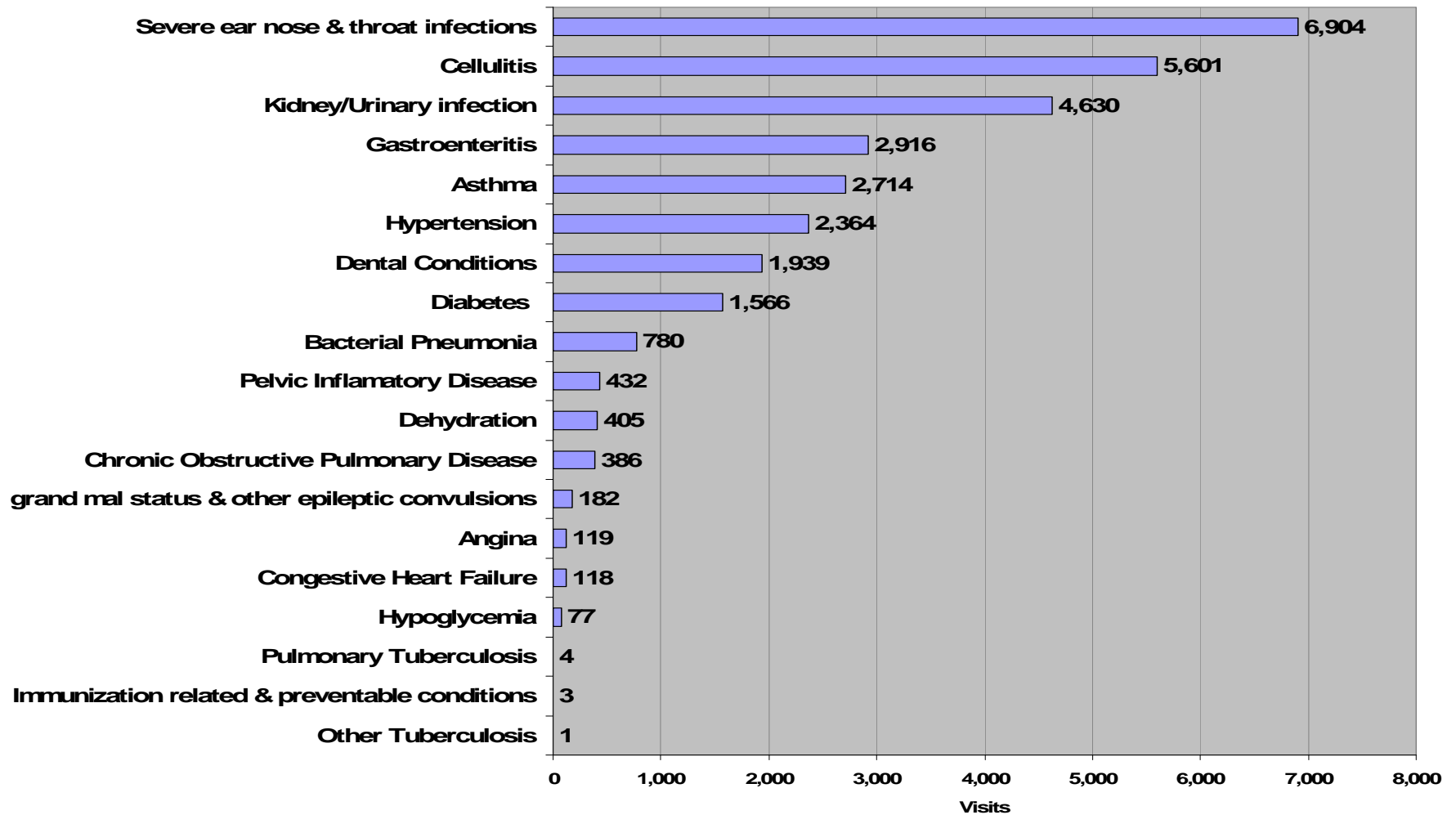
Most Frequent Diagnoses by MDC Residents Admitted to the ER, 2005



Our care management design criteria involved the study of the 10 most frequent ER diagnoses (2005)

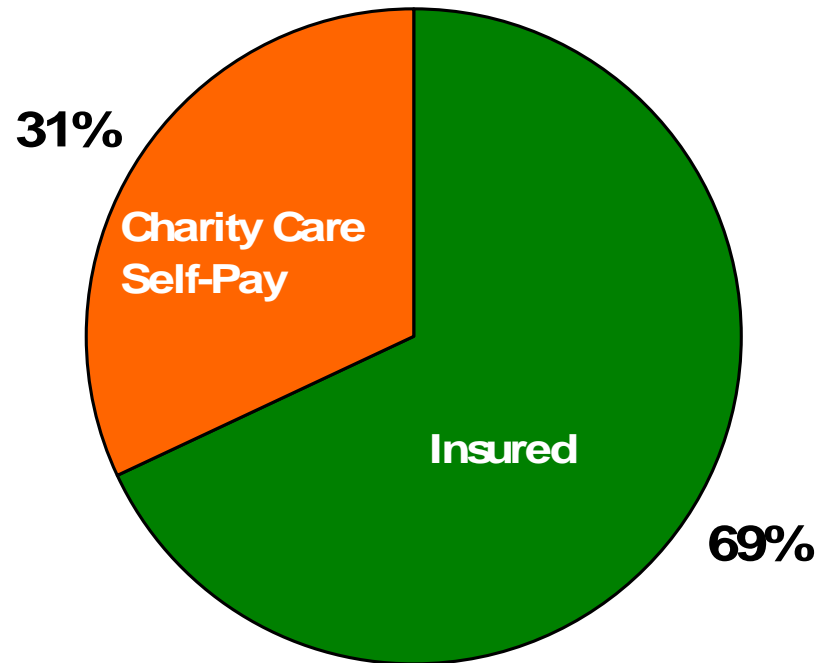
We determined that 4 (yellow bars) were for CDC-defined ACS conditions that may have been treatable in a primary care setting

In 2005, for MDC Residents aged 18-64, more than \$23 million worth of charity care was provided in our ERs for Ambulatory Care Sensitive Conditions
