COST SAVINGS

- Reduction in hospital utilization
- Annual cost savings resulting from improved health indicators
 - Hgb Alc
 - Blood pressure
 - LDL



ANNUAL COST SAVINGS*

Hbg Alc

- Good control = \$279
- Blood pressure
 - Reduced < 130/80 = \$464
- LDL
 - Reduced to <100mg/dl = \$369
