 - **Model 7 Mike Gingras \$25** Million New GR to cover increase in exemptions; updated with 2007 FHURS; Tiered Exemptions; Allocation Factor of 114.758%;
 - Model 10 Paul Belcher Begin with Model 8; increase Primary Care on Table 1 by \$5.0 million; increase CHD by \$1.0 million and FQHC by \$1.0 million; change exemption level to 9% threshold Use same tiers as Model 8 100%, 95%, 90% and 50%; Table 2 allocation factor of 114% and move balance generated to proportional adjustment column and spread according to current formula;
 - Model 11 John Benz Begin with Model 9; \$10 million funding of Primary Care Innovation: Allocate to hospital-based primary care centers that are approved by the LIP Council via an application for funding; LIP 5 participation limited to providers with at least 5% combined Medicaid and Charity utilization. Consistent with CMS approved definition of LIP cost limit, exclude bad debt days from allocation basis; allocation factor of 115.6 %; increase in DSH funds allocated to hospitals based on hospital PSN inpatient days;
 - Model 12 Dwight Chenette Anticipates \$25 million in General Revenue; level funding for FQHCs and CHDs, uses a allocation factor of 114%; revises the threshold for LIP 5 from 10% to 12%; reduces safety net payments by 5%; allocates \$50 million to fund demonstration programs that provide health coverage for uninsured residents of Florida through premium assistance or alternative health coverage models.
