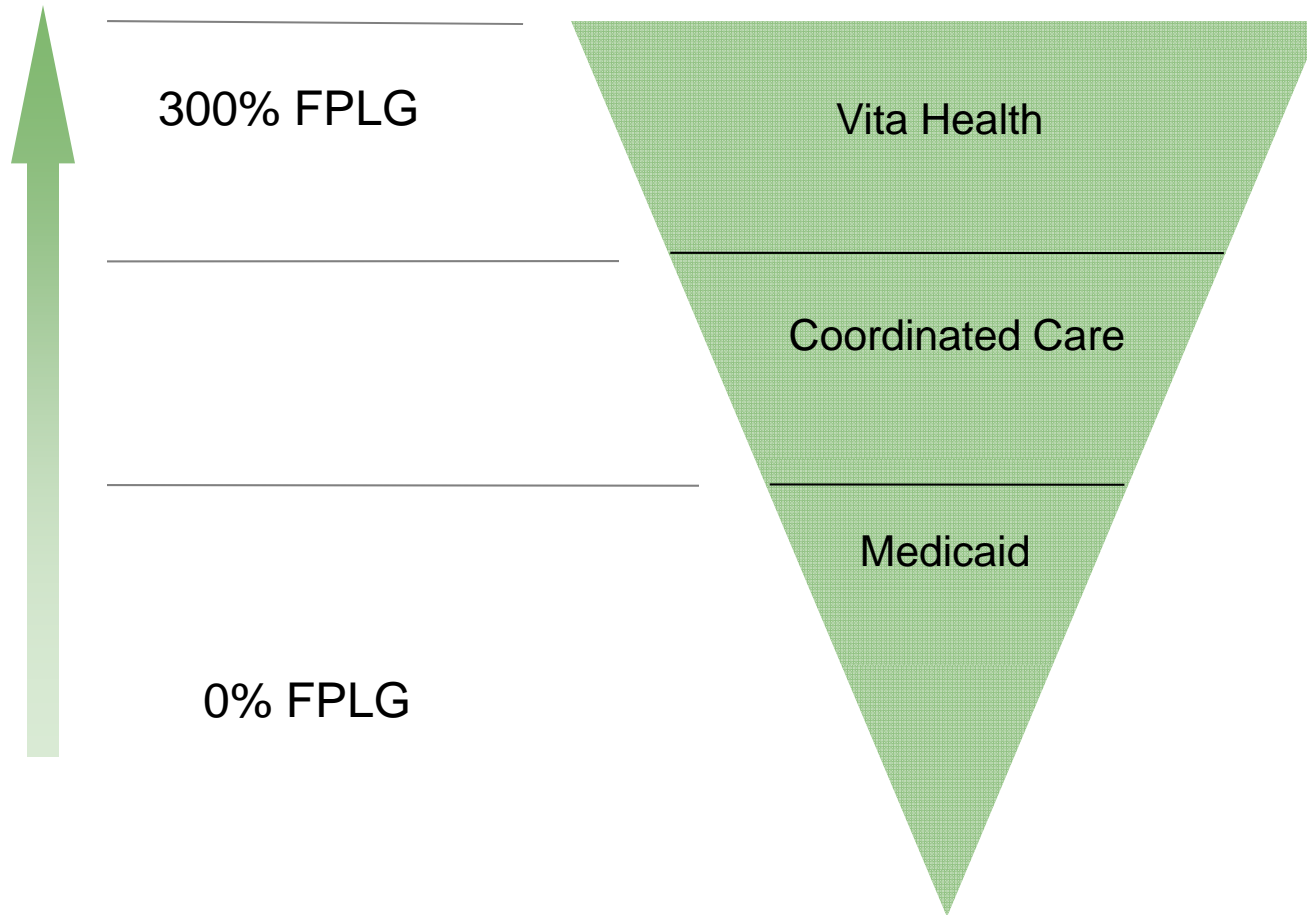
Original Proposal to LIP



To create a demonstration project whereby local financial resources can be leveraged to establish premium assistance under existing state health coverage programs that leads to fewer uninsured residents and provides greater access to health care services.

- IGT's of \$13.4 million
- Received \$15.9 million
- \$25.5 million funds for other state initiatives

Coverage Options



Vita Health Program



- Offer low cost coverage with two-thirds paid under the demonstration project and the balance paid by an individual with income below \$32,490 (FPL<300%) under Health Flex
- Eligibility criteria – not eligible for Federal or State programs, uninsured for last 6 months (unless lost eligibility in Medicaid/KidCare within 90 days), provide proof of PBCo. residency, and be between ages of 1 and 65
- Member monthly premium ranges from \$30 - \$125 per month

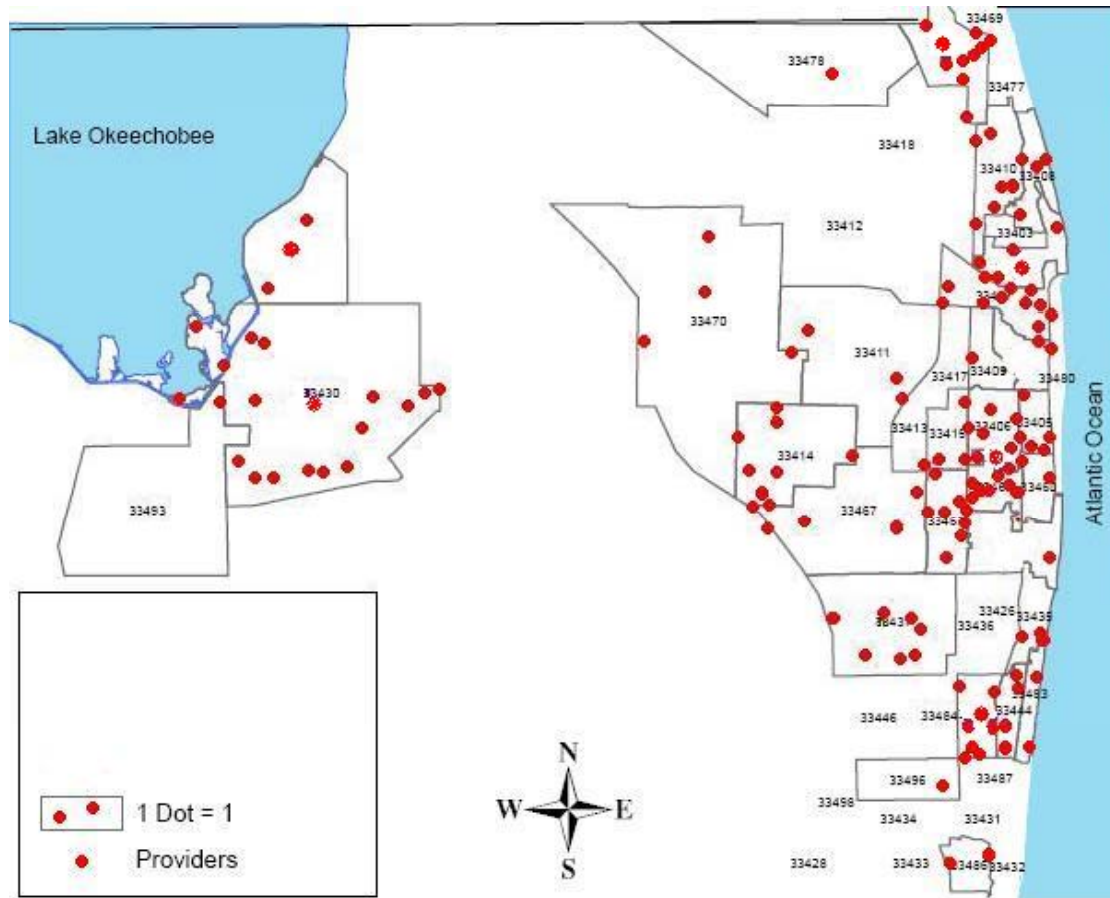
Vita Health Program

- Designed exclusively for working individuals and families whose employers do not offer health benefits for full and part-time employees and individuals who are self employed
- Medical benefits – primary care and specialty physician care, hospital based services, radiology and lab services and prescription drug

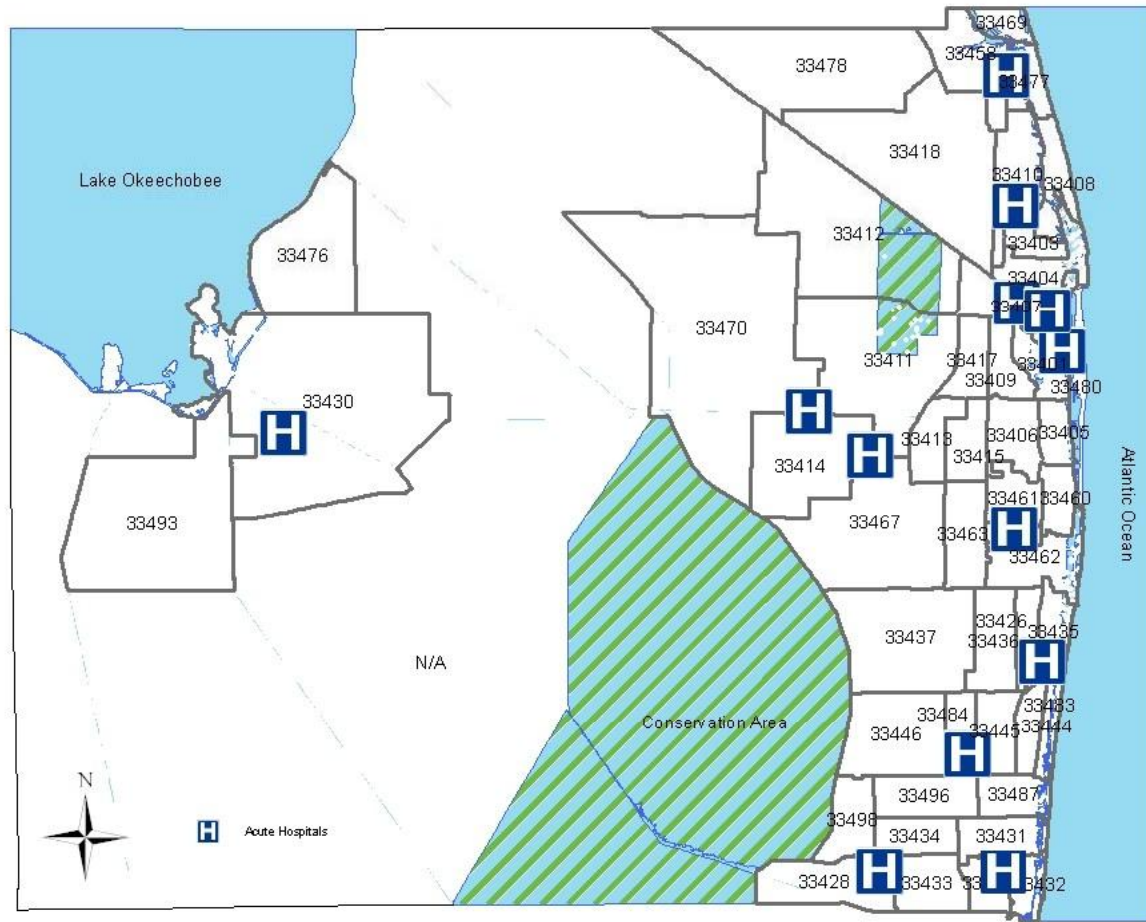
Coordinated Care Program

- Offer no cost coverage for individuals with income below \$16,245 (FPL<150%) and assets below \$5,000 with one-third of cost paid through demonstration project, balance paid locally
- Program closely coordinated with other State and Federal programs – no duplicate funding occurs
- Medical benefits – primary care, hospital based services, radiology and lab services and prescription drugs.

2009/2010 Accomplishments



- Primary Care Encounters – 25,423
- OB/GYN Encounters – 10,274
- Number of Prescriptions Filled – 342,384
- Laboratory Services – 72,459
- Radiology Services – 63,954
- Specialty Provider Encounters – 155,472

2009/2010 Accomplishments

- Top diagnoses include hypertension, cardiovascular disease and diabetes
- Top out-patient procedures include diagnostic colonoscopy and mammography

Request for 2010/2011



- Expand the allowable IGTs in the Palm Beach County project to \$26M
- Demonstration project would receive \$30M (\$4M net of IGT) and contribute \$50M to support other LIP Expenditures
- Additional expenditures will support growth in enrollment based on economy
- Investment will reduce uncompensated care for hospitals, doctors and clinics as well as promoting a medical home
- Demonstration project serves as an Emergency Room diversion by establishing a medical home for enrollees
