Florida HIE Quarterly Planning Report

1. Summary of Quarterly Activities

The following activities have been completed during the fourteenth quarter of execution of the Florida Health Information Exchange (Florida HIE) program. This covers the period from August 1, 2014 through October 31, 2014.

The development team completed the transition of Direct Secure Messaging (DSM) to the new Direct Messaging vendor Inpriva on August 9, 2014. An archive retrieval request from the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) was processed.

For the Event Notification Service (ENS) the team investigated software configurations and formalized internal documentation to support the increased data source count. The team also investigated the options for connectivity for ENS data sources and how to approach different methodologies that are available. The team piloted a virtual private network (VPN) connection for two data sources and determined VPN connection requirements. ENS connectivity sessions were scheduled through January 31, 2014 for hospital data sources participating in the Low Income Pool eligibility program. The development team held connectivity sessions to connect hospital data sources for admit, discharge, and transfer (ADT) feeds to the Florida HIE ENS. By the end of October 32 hospitals connected to ENS in production and 84 hospitals completed test connections. There were no ENS transactions this period.

Patient Look-Up (PLU) production nodes include Strategic Health Intelligence, Atlantic Coast HIE, Florida Hospital/Adventist Health System, UF Health, Broward Health, Martin Health System, Bethesda Health, and Senior Home Care – (an affiliate of Kindred at Home). PLU produced 39 successful transactions during the month of October. The PLU deployment team continued onboarding progress with the Department of Health (DOH), Community Health System (CHS), Orlando Health, Tampa Bay Regional Health Information Organization (RHIO), and Community Health IT. The team participated in the PLU User Group meetings in August and October and facilitated the Technical User Group meeting in September.

The remaining Deployment and Outreach Subcontractor is CHS (formerly HMA) and has one final milestone (PLU onboarding) to complete.




