



Cost of Services on the Health Care System

To further highlight the cost of services on the health care system, facilities were asked to breakdown their costs attributed to illegal aliens to federal, state, and local funds. The local funds for inpatient and outpatient services cost **\$0.70M**, while state and federal funds for inpatient and outpatient services cost **\$104.91M** and **\$5.30M**.

Total costs attributed to illegal aliens were **\$312.92M**. Facilities were paid **\$103.49M**. There is a **\$209.43M** difference between facility costs and how much facilities were paid, meaning facilities were paid for **33%** of costs attributed to illegal aliens.

142 of the **316** facilities stated charity expenditures included illegal aliens. The facilities utilized local charity, state charity, and federal charity funds of **\$1.23M**, **\$5.43M**, and **\$0.15M**.

There were a total of **111,475** illegal alien encounters and **23,358** illegal alien hospital admissions.
