HEALTH CARE RESPONSIBILITY ACT (HCRA)

INCOME LIMITS

(100% of the Federal Poverty Level)

(Does Not Include Income Limits for Counties Eligible for the Spend-Down Provision)

If family unit's gross income is <= the amount shown on the chart for a household of the same size, then the applicant has met the income criterion for the HCRA program and may be eligible to participate.

If the family unit's gross income is > the amount shown on the chart for a household of the same size, then the applicant has not met the income criterion for the HCRA program and is not eligible to participate, unless he or she is a resident of a spend-down provision eligible county.
