A multi-year transformation of legacy Medicaid technology, business processes, and operations from the Florida Medicaid Management Information System (FMMIS)

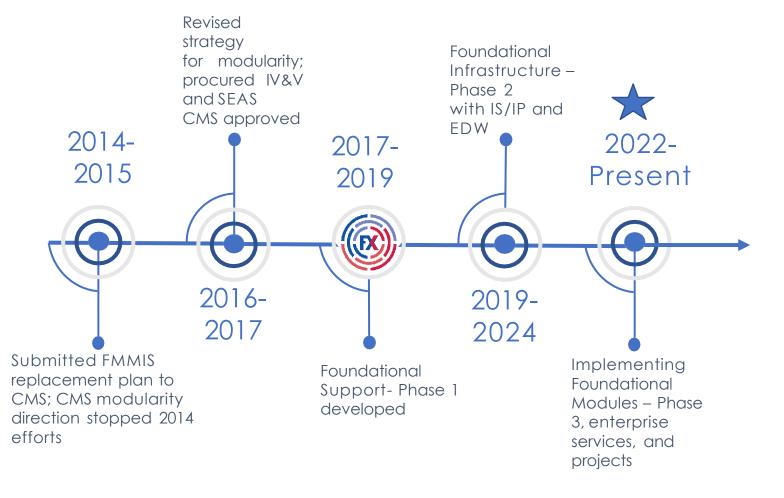

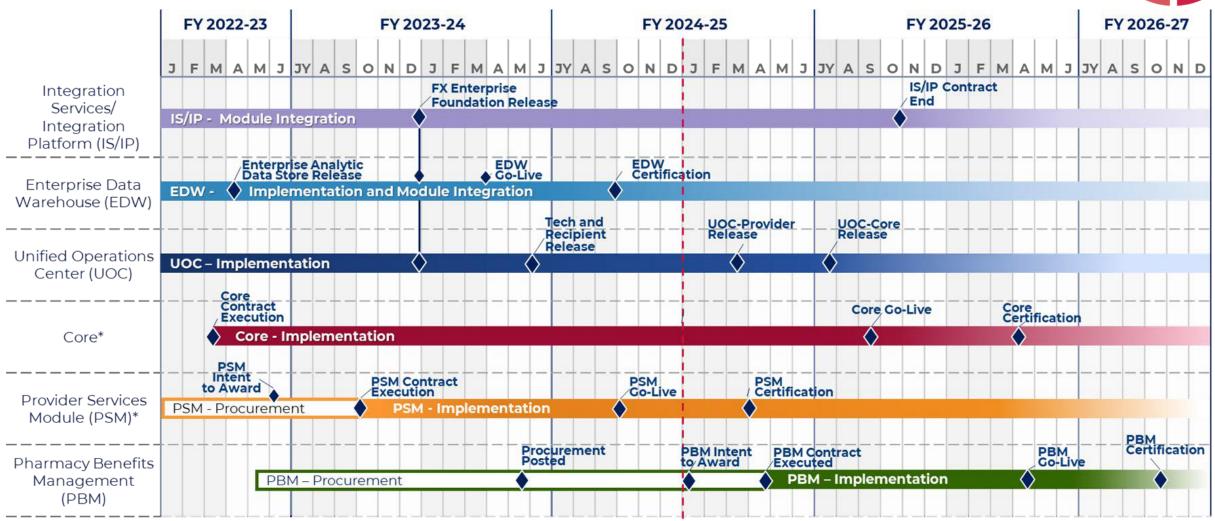

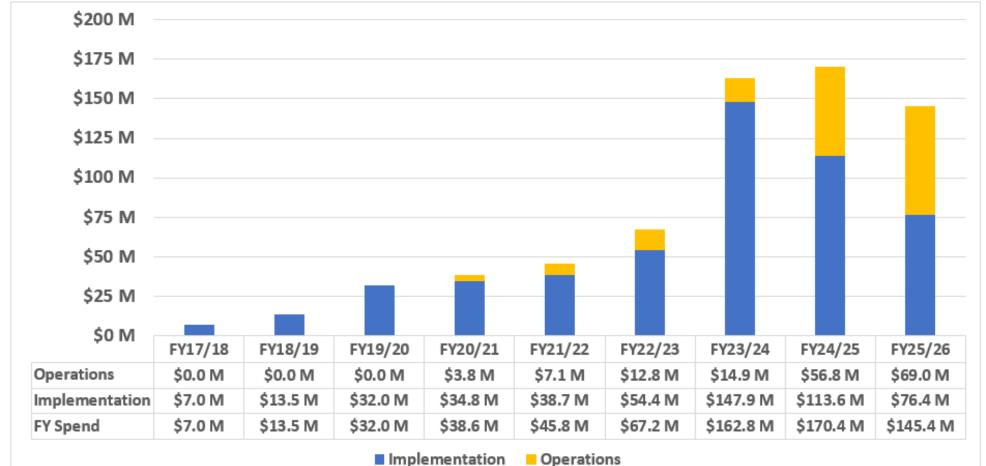
