



**OneBlood Daily Blood Inventory Report  
October 9, 2024**

Dear Hospital Partners,

**The following is important information regarding the blood supply and services.**

Hurricane Milton is tracking toward Florida's West Coast and will impacted a large portion of OneBlood's service area.

**What You Need to Know**

- OneBlood distribution hubs in St. Petersburg, Orlando and Jacksonville are operating with a reduced staff.
- For safety reasons, the OneBlood transportation team is not able to be on the road with winds higher than 35 miles per hour.
- We have provided our hospital partners with additional blood products prior to Milton's arrival.
- OneBlood inventory for red cells and platelets is stable.
- To ensure sufficient inventory of O Positive and Platelets we have implemented a one-day par level.
- The supply of O Negative is currently at a one-day level.

**We strongly encourage judicious use of O Negative, at this time.**

- All other blood types are available on demand.
- We have suspended blood collections in the parts of our service area that are in the storms path.
- We have issued urgent appeals to our donors and the news media in areas where we remain operational.

**Platelet Inventory**

- OneBlood's platelet inventory is stable, at this time
- We are manufacturing pooled platelets to further enhance the platelet inventory before, during and after the storm
- We are also importing platelets to further enhance supply

**Red Blood Cell Inventory**

- Inventory of O Negative is at a one-day level
- Inventory of all other blood types are stable
- Low Titer O Whole Blood inventory is stable
- Rare unit inventory is stable

**Frozen Products**

- Plasma product inventory is stable.

**Intercept Fibrinogen Complex (IFC)**

- IFC products are available in all of our Distribution sites.

### **COVID Convalescent Plasma (CCP)**

- All blood types are available, at this time.

### **Reference Laboratory Services**

- The Reference Laboratories are open.
- If there is an urgent need for red cell antigen negative units or platelet testing, please be aware of possible pick-up and delivery delays due to the weather.
