## **CMP Application Submission Checklist**

To avoid delays in the review process, the Applicant, State Agencies (SAs), and CMS Locations may reference this checklist as a guide to ensure the proposed submission has fulfilled the requirements and meets application criteria for review by the CMPRP Team.

 $\Box$  The applicant has submitted a project/program that CMS lists in the Allowable Uses of CMP Reinvestment funds (Attachment A) of the **QSO-23-23-NHs Memorandum.** 

□ The maximum project funding per nursing home, per year - \$5,000 (max of \$15,000 for a threeyear project) is met or a detailed justification is provided within the application. (Note: Resident and Family Councils and Consumer Information projects have a \$5,000 one-time funding limit.)

□ The application is signed and dated. It is recommended that the signature and date be within 6 months of receipt by CMS Locations.

• It is recommended that applications relating to conferences/training be submitted to the CMPRP Team at least 90 days in advance to allow adequate time for review.

 $\Box$  The applicant has used the most current CMS application template, or a similar template that mirrors the CMS-approved application template. The similar template must have all information requested in the CMS application template.

 $\Box$  The applicant has used the most current CMS budget (Excel) template, or a similar template that mirrors the CMS-approved budget (Excel) template.

 $\Box$  All sections of the application are completely filled out, or there is an indication of N/A in sections that are not completed.

 In addition, specifically if it is an extension or continuation project and all sections of the application are not required to be filled out, then the application indicated N/A in those sections.

□ Letters of support (LOS) for ALL participating nursing homes are provided at the time of submission.

- Please note that starting October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, all applications submitted to State Agencies (SAs) must include LOS with an acknowledgment that the proposed project funding will count against a nursing home's allocated budget for that project category. Applications submitted to SAs before October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 are not required to include LOS with an acknowledgment that funding will count against a nursing home's allocated budget.
- The commitment letter must display:
  - The project title
  - Time frame of the project
  - The nursing home's CMS certification number (CCN)
  - Acknowledgement that the funding request counts against the nursing home maximum cap as identified in memo QSO-23-23-NH.
  - and must be signed by an individual authorized to commit the nursing home.

• Any exceptions will require sufficient justification.

 $\hfill\square$  The applicant has provided legible names and CCNs for all nursing homes that are included in the project.
