- (3) Health care practitioners and health care providers may choose to require a visitor to wear a facial covering only when the visitor is:
 - (a) through (c) No change.
- (d) Visiting a patient whose treating health care practitioner has diagnosed the patient with or confirmed a condition affecting the immune system in a manner which is known to increase risk of transmission of an infection from <u>visitors</u> employees without signs or symptoms of infection to a patient and whose treating practitioner has determined that the use of facial coverings is necessary for the patient's safety.
