# ALINIA® (nitazoxanide)

### **LENGTH OF AUTHORIZATION**: 3 days

#### **REVIEW CRITERIA:**

## Diarrhea caused by Clostridium Difficile:

• Redirect provider to metronidazole or vancomycin

#### Diarrhea caused by Giardia lamblia:

• Redirect provider to metronidazole

### Diarrhea caused by Cryptosporidium parvum:

- May approve in the immunocompromised patient for:
  - o Children 1 to 3 years of age: 100 mg orally twice daily for 3 days;
  - o Children 4 to 11 years age: 200 mg twice daily for 3 days;
  - o Children ≥ 12 years and adults: 500 mg orally twice daily for 3 days

### **DOSING AND ADMINISTRATION:**

- Available as 500 mg tablets and 100 mg/5 mL oral suspension.
