H2015 H2015 HQ	Comprehensive Community Support Services for Substance Abuse (Peer Recovery Support) These services are designed to assist clients to strengthen and/or regain skills, to develop the environmental support necessary to help clients thrive in the community, and to aid clients in meeting life goals that promote recovery and resiliency. Services include substance abuse education, family/parenting guidance, life skills, anger/stress management, and support counseling.
