



2013 Stage One Meaningful Use Eligible Professional Quick Reference

CORE MEASURES: Must meet all 13

- Computerized Physician Order Entry (CPOE) for more than 30% of all patients (OR medication orders) by licensed healthcare professional
- Implement Drug-Drug and Drug –Allergy Checks
- Maintain up-to-date problem list of current and active diagnosis for more than 80% of patients
- E-Rx for more than 40% of permissible drug scripts
- Maintain Active Medication List for more than 80% of all patients
- Maintain Active Medication Allergy List of for than 80% of all patients
- Record Patient Demographics for more than 50% of all patients
- Record smoking status for more than 50% of patients 13 years and older
- Record and Chart Vital Sign for more than 50% of patients 2 years old and older **OR** blood pressure for patients 3 years old and older **AND** height and weight for all patients
- Implement One Clinical Decision Support Rule
- Provide more than 50% of all patients, who request, an electronic copy of their health record within 3 business days
- Provide patients with clinical summaries for more than 50% of office visits within 3 business days
- Protect electronic health information (privacy and security assessment)

MENU SET MEASURES: Select 5 out of the 10 (one must be a public health measure*)

- Implement drug formulary checks
- Incorporate clinical lab results into EHR for more than 40% of all lab results ordered
- Generate lists of patients by specific condition
- Send patient reminders for more than 20% of all patients 65 years and older and 5 years or younger
- Provide patients with electronic access to their health record for at least 10% of all patients within 4 business days
- Provide patient-specific education resources to more than 10% of all patients
- Perform medication reconciliation for more than 50% of patients received through transition of care
- Provide summary care report for more than 50% of patients referred or transitioned for care
- *Capability to submit electronic data to immunization registries
- *Capability to submit syndromic surveillance data to public health agencies

Clinical Quality Measures (CQMs): Report on three from core or alternate core AND an additional 3 CQMs out of the total of 38

CORE

- ✓ Adult Weight Screening
- ✓ Preventative Care and Screening measure pair:
 - (a) Tobacco Use Assessment
 - (b) Tobacco cessation intervention
- ✓ Hypertension: Blood Pressure Measurement

ALTERNATE CORE

- ✓ Weight Assessment and Counseling for children and adolescents
- ✓ Preventative Care Screening: Influenza Immunization for patients 50 years or older
- ✓ Childhood Immunization Status
