

WHERE CAN YOUR CHILD GET A CHILD HEALTH CHECK-UP?

Your child's **Doctor**, your **County Health Department**, or your **Community Health Center**

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM A CHILD HEALTH CHECK-UP:

- A health and developmental history
- A complete physical exam
- Immunizations (shots) and Lab Tests as needed
- Vision and hearing screenings
- A check of your child's eating habits and development
- A referral for a dental check-up
- Health education to tell you how to prevent accidents and diseases and to answer your questions about your child's growth and development
- Diagnosis and treatment, if necessary

MORE MEDICAID SERVICES

YOUR CHILD CAN GET THESE SERVICES IF A DOCTOR DECIDES YOUR CHILD NEEDS THEM:

- Doctor Services
- Vision care, including eye exams and glasses
- Lab tests and X-rays
- Medicines
- Medical equipment, including wheelchairs and medical supplies
- Hearing services, including hearing aids
- Dental care includes check-ups, cleanings, fillings and more
- Speech services
- Mental health services
- Hospital services, including psychiatric hospitals
- Help with drug, tobacco and alcohol abuse
- Physical, respiratory and occupational therapy
- Home health services
- Private Duty Nursing

AS LONG AS IT IS MEDICALLY NECESSARY, YOU CAN EXPECT:

- No co-payment
- No limit on approved services
