#### THE FLORIDA KIDCARE PROGRAM

Florida KidCare is a health insurance program for children in Florida. It includes Medicaid for children and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). Enrollment is based on the age of the child, family income and health care needs.

#### Florida KidCare programs:

- Medicaid for children
  - » Birth through age 18 years
- CHIP programs
  - » MediKids for uninsured children ages 1 through 4 years
  - » Healthy Kids for uninsured children ages 5 through 18 years
  - » Children's Medical Services (CMS) Plan - for uninsured children ages 1 through 18 years with special health care needs

#### **MEDICARE**

Medicare is the federal health insurance program for people who are 65 or older, certain younger people with disabilities, and people with permanent kidney failure requiring dialysis or a transplant (sometimes called ESRD)
