COVID-19: Frequency of Wrap-around Submissions for Federally Qualified Health Centers

The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) recognizes the impact that the 2019 novel coronavirus (COVID-19) is having on Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) providers. This alert gives guidance related to supplemental wrap-around submissions.

The Agency is allowing for a temporary change to the submission frequency for the supplemental wrap-around payment requests. The FQHCs are currently required to submit supplemental payment requests on a quarterly basis. To assist with cash flow during the state of emergency, FQHCs will be allowed to submit supplemental payments on a monthly basis. The allowance for monthly submission shall be in effect from April 1, 2020 through 60 days after the end of the state of emergency declared under Executive Order No. 20-51.

We appreciate the critical service you provide to some of the state's most vulnerable individuals. Please be aware that federal and state guidance related to COVID-19 is updated continuously. The Agency will communicate updates as quickly as possible.
