## United Healthcare of Florida, Inc. Transportation Vendor Transition to Logisticare

Beginning August 1, 2020, non-emergency transportation services for United Healthcare of Florida, Inc. (United) will be provided by Logisticare. United is a Statewide Medicaid Managed Care (SMMC) plan operating in regions 3, 4, 6 and 11.

All pre-scheduled and standing transportation trips for dates of service on or after August 1, 2020 will be automatically transferred to Logisticare.
