National Provider Identifier (NPI) Requirements

The Agency for Health Care Administration and its fiscal agent, Gainwell Technologies, have initiated an effort to eliminate the National Provider Identifier (NPI) Crosswalk methodology used for claims and encounter processing. Providers will see multiple changes to the secure Web Portal over the next few months.

Providers are encouraged to stay connected by visiting the <u>NPI Crosswalk Enhancement</u> page on the Florida Medicaid Public Web Portal often for the most up-to-date information. Providers should also log onto their account in the secure Web Portal. Providers who are required to take action to update their information will be notified through the secure Web Portal and provided with instructions and the deadline to update information.
