Update for Hospice Services Provided to Recipients in Dual Eligible Special Needs Plans (D-SNP)

On December 14, 2020, Florida Medicaid distributed a Health Care Alert allowing certain provider types to continue to bill fee-for-service for Medicaid covered services for individuals enrolled in Dual Eligible Special Needs plans (D-SNPs) until a new implementation date has been determined. This Alert supersedes the December 14, 2020 Alert.

In order to align with Medicare guidelines, the Agency for Health Care Administration will continue to allow hospice providers to bill fee-for-service for Medicaid covered services for recipients enrolled in D-SNPs.

D-SNPs enroll individuals dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid and provide Medicare services, with the exception of Medicare hospice services. Providers bill Medicare-covered hospice services to Medicare fee-for-service, not the D-SNP. Any services not covered by Medicare can continue to be billed fee-for-service for Medicaid coverage.
