## Florida Medicaid Health Care Alert June 18, 2021

## ICF/IID providers can continue to bill fee-for-service for Medicaid covered services provided to recipients enrolled in Dual Eligible Special Needs Plans (D-SNP)

On May 3, 2021, Florida Medicaid distributed a Health Care Alert informing certain provider types that effective July 1, 2021, the Florida Medicaid Management Information System (FMMIS) will no longer pay for services billed to Medicaid for recipients enrolled in a Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (D-SNP).

The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) will continue to allow Intermediate Care Facilities (ICF/IID) providers to bill Fee-for-Service for Medicaid covered services for recipients enrolled in a D-SNP.
