## Statewide Medicaid Managed Care (SMMC) Policy Transmittal: 2019-08

Applicable to the **2018-2023 SMMC contract benefits** for:

- Managed Medical Assistance (MMA) and MMA Specialty
- Long-Term Care (LTC)
- Dental

### Re: Update to PT 2019-02 Medical Foster Care Ad Hoc Report

The managed care plan may be required to provide the Agency or its agents information or data relative to this contract. In such instances, and at the direction of the Agency, the managed care plan must fully cooperate with such requests and furnish all data or information in a timely manner, in the format in which it is requested. The managed care plan must have at least thirty (30) days to fulfill such ad hoc requests, unless the Agency directs the managed care plan to provide data or information in less than 30 days. The managed care plan must verify that data and information it submits to the Agency is accurate. (Attachment II, Section XVI.A.1.b.) The purpose of this policy transmittal is to inform the managed care plan of an update to the ad hoc request for provider education and training materials for medical foster care (MFC) providers that was in PT 2019-02.

The managed care plan must use the **revised report template** attached to this policy transmittal, in accordance with the instructions tab in the template, for all future submissions of the MFC ad hoc report. The managed care plan must continue to submit the MFC report to the Agency **by noon, Eastern Time, every Wednesday until the managed care plan receives further notice from the Agency.**
