## Statewide Medicaid Managed Care (SMMC) Policy Transmittal: 2019-19

Applicable to the 2018-2023 SMMC contract benefits for:

- Managed Medical Assistance (MMA) and MMA Specialty
- Long-Term Care (LTC)
- Dental

## **Re: Medical Foster Care Services Reporting**

The managed care plan must comply with all reporting requirements set forth in the contract, including reports specific to the MMA managed care program as specified in the Summary of Reporting Requirements Table below and the Managed Care Plan Report Guide. (Attachment II, Exhibit II-A, Section XVI.A.) The purpose of this policy transmittal is to notify the managed care plan of the discontinuance of the weekly medical foster care services ad hoc report and the revision of the monthly medical foster care services report template.

Effective with the date of this policy transmittal, the managed care plan will no longer submit the weekly medical foster care services ad hoc report required by policy transmittals 2019-01 and 2019-08. The Agency has incorporated the weekly medical foster care services ad hoc report into the revised monthly medical foster care services report template attached to this policy transmittal, and incorporated into Chapter 32 of the Managed Care Plan Report Guide effective September 1, 2019. The managed care plan must use the revised medical foster care services report template attached to this policy transmittal, effective with the monthly submission due to the Agency by close of business on October 15, 2019.
