**Statewide Medicaid Managed Care (SMMC) Policy Transmittal: 2020-02**

Applicable to the following benefits in the **2018-2023 SMMC contract**:

- Managed Medical Assistance (MMA) and MMA Specialty
- Long-term Care (LTC)
- Dental

**Re: MMA Performance Measures for July 1, 2020 Reporting**

The managed care plan must collect and report on a list of thirty-nine (39) performance measures, certified via a qualified auditor. (Attachment II, Exhibit II-A, Section IX.B.1.a.) The purpose of this policy transmittal is to provide revised requirements for the MMA performance measures for July 1, 2020 reporting.

Discontinued Performance Measures for July 1, 2020 Reporting

Beginning with July 1, 2020 reporting, for calendar year 2019 services, the managed care plan must no longer report on the following performance measures.

<b>Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS)</b>	
21.	Annual Monitoring for Patients on Persistent Medications - (MPM)
24.	Use of Multiple Concurrent Antipsychotics in Children and Adolescents - (APC)
<b>HEDIS &amp; Agency-Defined</b>	
31.	Follow-Up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness – (FHM)

Additional Performance Measure Change for July 1, 2020 Reporting

Beginning with July 1, 2020 reporting for calendar year 2019, the managed care plan is required to report on the HEDIS measure: Follow-up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH).
