Re: Community Behavioral Health Services

The managed care plan must provide community behavioral health services in accordance with Rule 59G-4.050, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). (Attachment II, Exhibit II-A, Section VI.A.1.a.) The purpose of the policy transmittal is to notify the managed care plan of rule changes related to community behavioral health services.

The Agency has repealed Rule 59G-4.050, F.A.C., the Florida Medicaid Community Behavioral Health Services Coverage and Limitations Handbook. The Agency revised, updated, and moved the requirements for community behavioral health services to the rules listed below.
