

Assistive Care Services in Statewide Medicaid Managed Care

Assistive Care Services (ACS) are an integrated set of 24-hour services only for eligible Medicaid recipients. The assistive care service is a required service in the Statewide Medicaid Managed Care program under both the Long-term Care program and the Managed Medical Assistance program.

Recipients must be Medicaid eligible and meet certain functional criteria to receive Assistive Care Services.
